DECISION AND REASONS

The Sub-Committee have considered whether interim steps are necessary in this case. They have considered the grounds set out in the application for summary review and the oral representations made by PC Dan Hunt on behalf of Kent Police. This included a presentation outlining the dates and times the premises were alleged to have breached the terms of their Licence. The Sub-Committee also heard from Mr Albert Lee, the premises licence holder who apologised for the issues at the premises and did not seek to challenge the application for the interim step of a suspension of the premises licence.

The Sub-Committee considered the representations made and the proposed interim step of suspension of the Licence requested by Kent Police intended to control the premises pending full review hearing. The determination of the Sub-Committee was that it was necessary, appropriate, and proportionate to suspend the licence pending the full review hearing.
