NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF DUAL HACKNEY CARRIAGE / PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Licensing Sub Committee were asked to consider whether is a fit and proper person for the purposes of compliance with hackney carriage and private hire legislation, published Standards and Guidance and Swale Borough Council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Vehicle Licensing Policy.
The Licensing Sub Committee heard evidence from , considered the licensing officer's report and carefully reviewed all of the evidence provided including the written statement provided in advance of the hearing and the emails received from and .
The Licensing Sub Committee felt that the reason for not declaring caution on renewal application was a genuine mistake, resulting from a misunderstanding of the circumstances and implications of caution.
The Licensing Sub Committee considered response to a number of questions surrounding the incident and found to be honest and genuine account.

The Licensing Sub Committee noted and gave weight to the very supportive emails that had been received concerning history and character. They also noted he had a long history as a licensed taxi driver in Swale with no previous concerns being raised.

The Licensing Sub Committee carefully considered the enforcement options available to them. In particular, they noted their policy regarding matters relating to violence and dishonesty. However they felt that the particular circumstances of this case justified the decision.

ACCORDINGLY THE DECISION OF THE LICENSING SUB COMMITTEE IS TO TAKE NO FURTHER ENFORCEMENT ACTION AND TRUST THE LICENCE WILL BE RENEWED IN THE USUAL WAY, WITHOUT THE EXISTING PENALTY POINTS BEING APPLIED.

There is no right of appeal against this decision.
